Barbara Maynard Waggoner of St. Louis, Missouri, formerly of Rolla, Missouri passed away Monday, January 16, 2015 at the Altenhiem Senior Living Community in St. Louis, at the age of 80. Barbara was born in Omaha, Nebraska on April 4, 1935 to the late Wilbert and Elizabeth (Newton) Maynard.
