Rolla, Missouri – Chester Castleman Green, Jr. passed away in Rolla Saturday morning, October 24th, 2015. He was born in Rolla to Chester Green, Sr. and Rosa neé Benad on January 7, 1928 and resided in Rolla his entire life except for his service in the Navy during WWII. He was a 1945 graduate of Rolla High School and a lifelong member of Immanuel Lutheran Church. He was a farmer, a cattleman, and worked for Production Credit Association for 19 years, was a co-owner of Hollenbeck Title Company in Vienna, served on the Thomas-Fairview Cemetery Board, and was a businessman in the local communities.
