Delman Franklin Barnett, of St. James Missouri, was born January 5, 1947 in St. Louis Missouri to Louie Elston and Edna Margaret Stender Barnett and passed away October 8, 2023 at the age of 76. He was preceded in death by his parents Louie and Edna Barnett; sisters Roxie Christine Gray and Darlene Edna Matlock; brothers Wilburn Barnett, Louie Delbert Barnett, Edward Barnett, and Jesse Barnett.

Delman was a man of God, country, and family.

Delman graduated from John Hodge High School in 1965. After graduating high school, he proudly served our country. He was drafted into the U.S. Army on March 8th, 1966. He attained the rank of SP/5 and was relieved of his service with honorable discharge on February 20th, 1968.

After returning home, Delman worked for Intercounty Electric for 40 years and retired there as area supervisor for the last 16 years there. Delman married his high school sweetheart and the love of his life, Lynda Ann Haacke. They were married on June 21, 1969 and spent 54 years together. He brought his

wife coffee every morning and bouquets of flowers from the fields and flower bed. They raised two daughters, Heather Lane Bullock, and Autumn Dawn Miller. Family was very important to Delman. He always made sure family was taken care of and put everyone before himself. Delman was a kind and loving man, who would do anything for anyone at any time.

Delman had a love for the outdoors. He found beauty in everything around him, especially on his farm. He enjoyed farming, gardening, hunting, and fishing. One year he planted 196 tomato plants to help his grandson pay for college. He enjoyed his cows and looked forward to the new calves. Many of his favorite memories were on his farm working cattle.

He is survived by his wife Lynda of St. James MO; daughters Heather Lane Bullock of Rolla, and Autumn Dawn Miller of St. James MO; sisters Geri Barnett of Rolla MO; and Velda and husband Gene Kossuth of St. James MO; brothers David and wife Kelly of St. James MO; Ronald Barnett of Seattle Washington; grandchildren Logan Franklin Barnett and wife Alexis Barnett of Sullivan MO; Kieran Alexander Evans and fiancé Shauna Rinehart of St. James MO; Trystan Jacob Evans of St. James MO; Abigail Lockard of Clarksville MO; Gus Bullock, and Olivia Bullock of Rolla MO; great-grandson Bryden Ross Barnett.
