Elsie Violet Chrisco of Rolla, MO, passed away Monday, May 4, 2015 at the age of 93. She was born in Phelps County, MO, on September 24, 1921 to the late Ernest and Evelena Stedman Haas. On February 8, 1947 she married Howard Chrisco who preceded her in death on August 24, 2006.

Elsie graduated from Rolla High School in 1939 and began what would evolve into a banking career with Rolla State Bank. Following her marriage to Howard and their relocation to a farm near Salem, MO she worked at the Bank of Salem for several years. Then they relocated back to the Rolla area in 1958 where she worked for local banks until she retired from US Bank in 1986. Elsie was noted for her strong work ethic and extreme care for her banking customers.

Elsie was a baptized believer who faithfully attended the St. James Church of God until her health declined. Elsie was a devoted wife and mother who enjoyed family gatherings, her church family, square dancing and traveling. She and Howard traveled throughout the United States to include Alaska and Hawaii. Internationally, they traveled to Europe and the Philippines, as well as Canada and Mexico.

In addition to her parents and husband, Mrs. Chrisco was preceded in death by one brother, Elmer Haas.

She will be greatly missed by her surviving family which includes two children, retired Army Colonel Larry Chrisco and wife, Connie of Rolla, MO and Leland Chrisco and wife, Sue of Neosho, MO; one sister, Opal Bennett Domeyer of

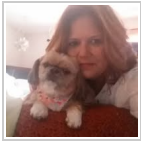
