Florence Texeira Sanders of Rolla, Missouri passed away Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at the age of 92. Florence was born in Kona, Hawaii on October 10, 1924 to the late Antone and Evangeline (DeGuair) Texeira.

Florence was raised on the Kona Island of Hawaii and graduated high school there. That is where she met the love of her life and soon to be husband, Garmal Sanders, who was stationed there. 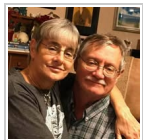
