Glenna Faye Nash, of Rolla, Missouri, formerly of Salem, Missouri, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, January 7, 2026, at the age of 96.

Glenna was born in Shannon County, Missouri, on March 30, 1929, to the late James and Carrie (Brawley) Woolf. After graduating from high school, she enrolled in college with the goal of becoming a schoolteacher. After attending one year, she met the love of her life, William E. “Bill” Nash. They were married on June 10, 1947, and this union was blessed with four children.

Bill and Glenna shared 55 wonderful years of marriage before Bill’s passing in 2002. Glenna was a devoted wife and mother. Her children often reflect on the loving care she gave their father, especially during his illness. The thought of placing him in the care of others never crossed her mind—she lovingly cared for him from the first day of their marriage until his final day on earth.
