Lloyd Franklin Riley of St. James, Missouri passed away Monday, February 4, 2019 at the Missouri Veterans Home, in St. James, Missouri at the age of 91. Lloyd was born in Rolla, Missouri on April 19, 1927 to the late James Lloyd and Ethel Ella (Cox) Riley.

On June 3, 1949 Lloyd married the love of his life, Miss Doris Marie Patterson, this union was blessed with two children. Lloyd proudly served his Country in the United States Army; he spent his entire life farming, raising cattle, and at one time hogs; when they raised dairy cattle Lloyd also worked for Tucker Dairy, going around to the farms collecting the milk cans and taking them back to the Dairy; He was a member, and served as a Deacon of the Macedonia Baptist Church, and was a 50 plus year member of the Plumbers and Pipe fitters Union.

Lloyd was a people person, a good listener, without being judgmental, he was a "go-to" guy for almost anything you needed, maybe a piece of equipment that needed fixed, something needing built, or if you just needed some words of wisdom, Lloyd was your guy; although he was very humble, and did not want any praise for his works, he did a lot of things that nobody even knew about. When it came time to build their home, he did it from the ground up, sawing every board himself out the trees that he cut down himself. He was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, uncle and friend, his finest quality was his patience, an inherent ability to listen, to absorb and to offer a

point of view based on quiet, measured wisdom. Finally, every day of his 69 years of marriage, he taught his children, and grandchildren what it meant to be a great husband. He married his sweetheart, he adored her, he laughed with her and cried with her, and was dedicated to her totally. We bid farewell as we mourn the lose of a lively, and dignified soul, a soul that brought joy and fulfillment to many, and whose legacy will live forever.
