



## Lucy Ann Greig

March 1, 1930 - December 15, 2024

Lucy Ann Greig of Versailles, Missouri, passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 15, 2024, at the Good Shepherd Care Center at the age of 94. Lucy was born in St. Louis, Missouri, on March 1, 1930, to the late Richard and Anna Mae (Altemiller) Cramm.

On July 3, 1948, Lucy was united in marriage to Eldon Dale Greig. Shortly after they married, they moved to the Greig farm in St. James, Missouri, where they raised seven children.
