Marjorie Ruth (Welch) Vogeler of Nashville, Tennessee, formerly of Rolla, Missouri passed away Monday, November 6, 2017 at the age of 90. She was born in Safe, Missouri on December 16, 1926 to the late Russell Edward and Ruth Mildred (Beckham) Welch.

Marjorie graduated from Rolla High School in 1944. She was united in marriage to the late Marvin Lester Vogeler on January 20, 1946. He was almost twenty years old and she was barely nineteen years old; this union was blessed with three children, Richard Dale in 1948, Vanna Gail in 1950 and David Alan in 1959.

She worked thirty-three years for the Federal Government, first at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri and then at the US Bureau of Mines before retiring. Their life wasn't fancy, but the two of them provided a comfortable life for their family and there was always plenty of love. For many years, the family enjoyed camping, which she and Marvin continued as long as he was able to do so. For several years (as they got older) she and Marvin spent their summers camping in the northern states and their winters in Texas, just staying warm. She very much enjoyed cooking and sewing. Again, it wasn't anything fancy, but especially around the holidays, the food was special and delicious... you know, "just like Mother used to make." She made several dresses and a couple of coats for Vanna. She loved to quilt, knit and crochet.

Through the years, she make countless quilts and afghans, plus special quilt squares to contribute to a quilt being raffled by some group of ladies trying to raise money for their cause. Even in her later years, as her eyesight and abilities were beginning to dwindle, she made sure that she made a special quilt for each of her children and grandchildren, with her name and the date of completion of the back of many of them. Those, especially, will be very deeply treasured quilts for years to come.

Marjorie is survived by her children, Richard (Brenda) Vogeler of Rolla, Missouri, Vanna (Bill) Schneider of Nashville, Tennessee and David (Vicki) Vogeler of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; thirteen grandchildren, twenty-one great-grandchildren and four great-great grandchildren.

In addition to her parents and husband of sixty-one years, Marjorie was preceded in death by one brother, Leonard Russell Welch.

Funeral services for Marjorie Vogeler will be held at 1:00PM on Friday, November 10, 2017 at the Rolla Chapel of the James and Gahr Mortuary with Pastor Dan Phillips officiating. Interment will be in the Ozark Hills Memorial Garden, Rolla, Missouri.
