Martha Louise Stumpf passed from this life on Sunday, January 23, 2022 at the St. James Living Center in St. James, Missouri at the age of 96. Martha was born November 11, 1925 in Benton County, Arkansas to the late Pierce Howard and Lucy Mae (Voltz) Mayfield.

Martha was a class of 1943 graduated from Pea Ridge High School in Arkansas. She graduated with honors to which she was awarded a scholarship to Draughon's Business College in Springfield, Missouri. After graduation from Draughon's, Martha went to work for KWTO radio station in Springfield, Missouri. It was there Martha met the love of her life, Clifford Stumpf, who was a professional entertainer at the station.
