



Mary Frances McIntosh

September 21, 1927 - December 8, 2020

Mary Frances (Gravatt) McIntosh, of Ellisville, Missouri, formerly of St. James and Salem, Missouri, passed away on Tuesday, December 8, 2020, at St. Luke's Hospital in Chesterfield, Missouri at the age of 93. Mary was born in Wesco, Missouri on September 21, 1927, to the late William and Ava (Roberts) Gravatt.

Mary graduated from John F. Hodge High School in St. James, Missouri, where she was class valedictorian. It was at John F. Hodge where she met the love of her life, Calvin "Mac" McIntosh. They married on November 30, 1947 and the union was blessed with two children. Mary attended the St. Louis Institute of Music, and later the Chicago School of Interior Design earning her Certificate of Interior Decorating. Mac and Mary returned to St. James and Mary taught piano. In 1962, they purchased the furniture and appliance store in Salem; in addition to selling home furnishings, Mary wrote a weekly newspaper column and designed for residential and commercial property throughout the Salem area. McIntosh Furniture closed in 1988, and following their retirement in Salem, Mary and Mac moved to the St. Louis area closer to family; they just celebrated their 73rd wedding anniversary in November.

Survivors include her husband Calvin "Mac" McIntosh; children Dennis McIntosh and wife Carla of Farmington, Missouri and Gail Doveikis and husband Phillip of Ballwin, Missouri; grandchildren Benjamin McIntosh

(Natalie), John McIntosh (Jodi), Samuel Doveikis (Rachel), and Kate Schneider (Brett); great grandchildren Helen, Rosalie, Kennedi, Sawyer, Finley, James and Mackenzie; and a host of extended family and friends.

Private graveside service for Mary Frances McIntosh will be held at the Oak Grove Cemetery in St. James, Missouri. The family will host a memorial service at a later date.
