Olive Helen Naramore of Salem, Missouri passed away March 17, 2015 at the Baptist Home in Ironton, Missouri at the age of 89. Olive was born March 27, 1925 in High Gate, Missouri to the late Charles Edmond Davis and Mary Christena Satterfield.
