Ronald Max Voight of Rolla, Missouri passed away on May 18, 2014 in Rolla at the age of 62. Ronald was born September 23, 1951 in Jefferson City, Missouri to William and Venita (Wood) Voight.

Ron was united in marriage to Patty (Haven) Voight for 37 years, and to this union they had two sons. Ron graduated from Rolla High School in 1969. He then attended Lincoln College before joining the Army National Guard. He served during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in 1975.
