Rosemary “Rosie” (Wolfe) Satterlee of Columbia, Missouri, via many places far and wide, peacefully began her journey home to her Heavenly Father on Monday, November 21, 2022, at the age of ninety-nine. Rosie was born in Springdale, Arkansas on April 23, 1923, to the late Mack and Mable (Ford) Wolfe.

Rosie met her future husband, John Satterlee in 1944 while he was recuperating from wounds he received in battle during World War II, at Fort Riley Hospital in Springfield, Missouri. They were married on December 21, 1944, and within two years had started their little family. Rosie spent most of her married life caring for John and their three sons, as a homemaker and housewife. She loved working with her hands, whether she was sewing clothing for her grandchildren, baking, or arranging beautiful baskets of flowers.

She will always be remembered for her love of her husband, sons and family, beautiful smile, warm, friendly character, and outgoing nature. She was a woman of Christian Faith in her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, and she truly loved the Lord with all her heart, as well as her neighbors and herself. Rosie is survived by two sons, Rod Satterlee of Columbia, Missouri and David Satterlee of Springfield, Missouri; six grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild; a host of extended family and
