



Stanley Beryl Derryberry

August 15, 1947 - December 30, 2014

Stanley "Stan" Beryl Derryberry, 67, was born August 15, 1947, in Waynesville, MO. Stan made San Antonio, TX his retirement home until November. Due to poor health, he was living with his daughter, Barbara, and family in Fort Worth until he passed Tuesday, December 30, 2014.

His parents were Beryl Edgar Derryberry and Eula Ethel Shults Derryberry. He is survived by his brother, Ronald Edgar Derryberry and wife, Nancy Ann Derryberry of Springfield, MO; mother to his children, Nancy Jay Christal and husband Jim; a son, Robert Allen Derryberry and wife, Kimberlee Derryberry of Boones Mill, VA; a daughter, Barbara Janine Derryberry Brockwell and husband, Stephen Mac Brockwell II of Fort Worth, TX; seven grandchildren: Sasha, Louis, Grafton, Molly, and Emilee (Robert's children); Jordyn and Stephen Mac (Barbara's children); and three great grandchildren, Rosie, Cyrus, and Cody (Sasha's children).

Stan had many hobbies throughout the years: golfing; target shooting; collecting coins, guns, antique carnival glass, antique oak furniture and two corvettes. He was quite proud of his 63 corvette and drove his 2006 corvette on many enjoyable cruises with the corvette club in San Antonio, TX.

Stan graduated from Licking High School, Licking, MO in 1965. He served with the U. S. Army, including a tour in Vietnam (1967-1968). After returning

from the Army he used his GI Bill and attended Missouri State University, Springfield, MO where he graduated in 1972. Upon acquiring his Missouri real estate salesman's and broker's licenses, Stan opened Derryberry Real Estate in Springfield, MO. Then, Stan began a civil service career working for billeting at Fort Leonard Wood, MO. He transferred to the housing department in Fort Irwin, CA and later went to Hanau, Germany; then back to Fort Irwin, CA before retirement in 2005.

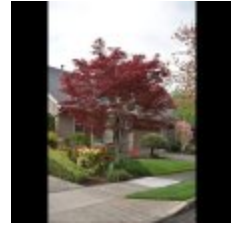
